Public Management Training in China: A Sino-Swiss Partnership 1986-1996

Abstract: The goal of this presentation is to describe the developments of China's effort in modernizing its public administration through a redesign of its training institutions and training capabilities. The paper first analyses the current situation of China's administrative training network and the need to upgrade the training approaches at the national level. As a second step, the paper sheds light on an example of technology transfer in the field of modern management training and institution development knowhow involving the authors institution and their Chinese counterparts' institution called China Training Centre for Senior Personnel Management Officials (CTCSPMO).
