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
ATC Technical Cooperation Project Different training objectives -

Key Tasks of the Swiss Expert on Location



- Presenting the ATC-seco programme and its mission
- Conducting WTO-accession impact survey
- Carrying out a half-day seminar on WTO Accession
- Identification of 3 country cases





Key Tasks of the Swiss Expert on Location (2)



- Joint selection with senior officials of 1 case from a pool of 3 cases
- Selection of five ATC/WTI trainees
- Preparation of case development and simulation and in country use subsequent to WTI course
- Obtaining the support of relevant Minister in ATC country



Expected Outputs



- A summary of results of the WTO Impact survey
- 1 priority topic for case study and simulation
- 1 information dissemination seminar on WTO conducted in country
- 5 ATC-WTI trainees selected
- A work plan developed for case study and simulation
- Letter of agreement with the counterpart obtained to conduct workshop in country based on the case study & simulation by the trainees after completion of the WTI course
